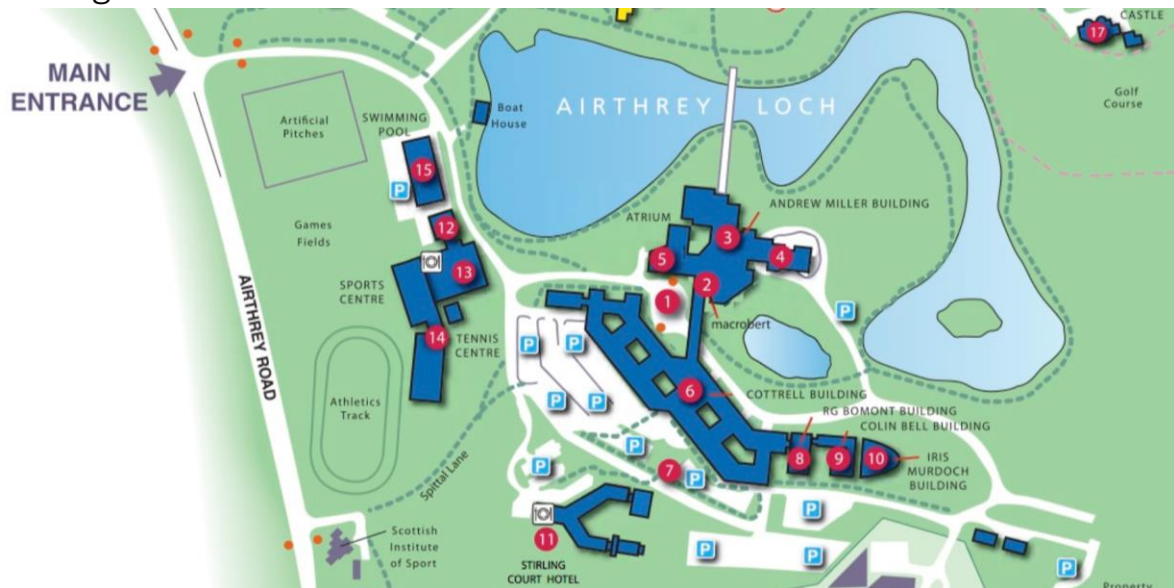

Public transport

The Iris Murdoch Building 10 is a 5-minute walk from the bus stops at the transport hub 7 shown on the map above.

By car

Car parks are indicated on the map. The University operates Pay & Display parking payable by cash or credit/debit card at onsite machines or via the RingGo app available at: ringgo.co.uk Parking costs around £1 per hour.

The University tends to be a little quieter at this time of year, but we would advise drivers arrive in plenty of time to find a parking space and reach the Iris Murdoch Building for 2.00pm.

Accessibility

Blue badge holders can park free of charge and there are 3 accessible spaces outside the Iris Murdoch Building.

The seminar takes place on the first floor of the Iris Murdoch Building. There is step-free access to the building. The first floor can be reached via one flight of stairs or the lift.
