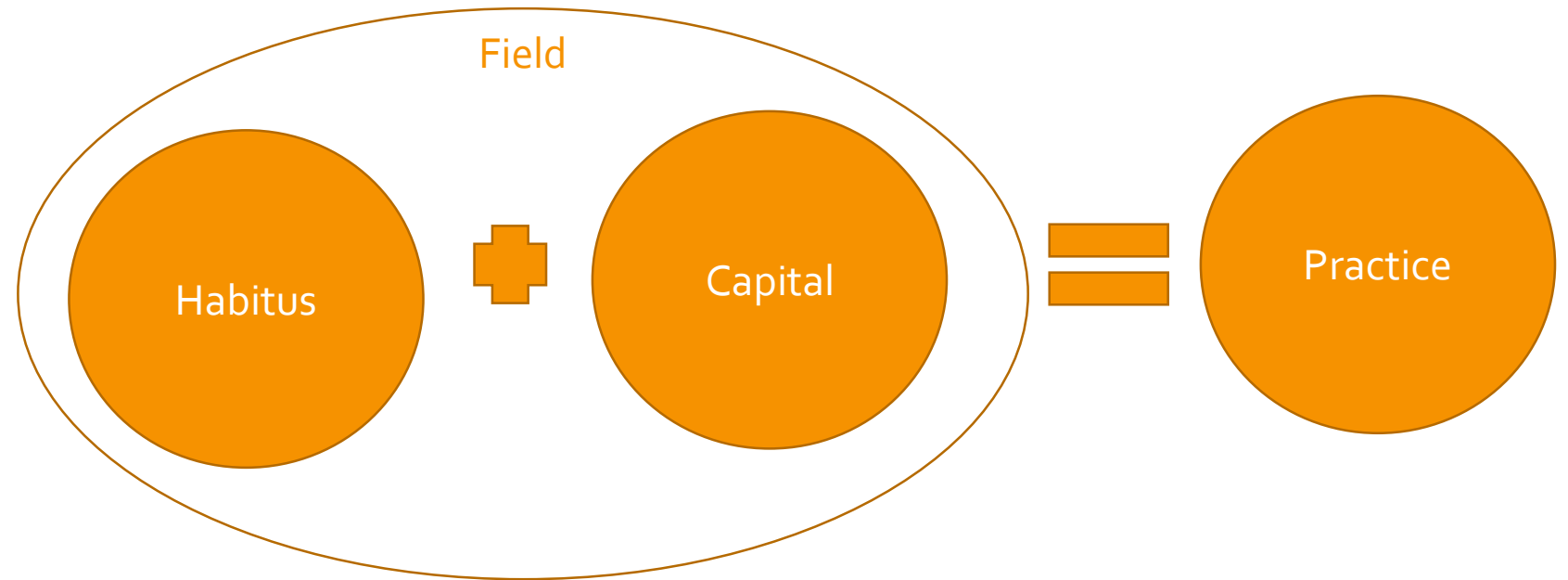
# Method

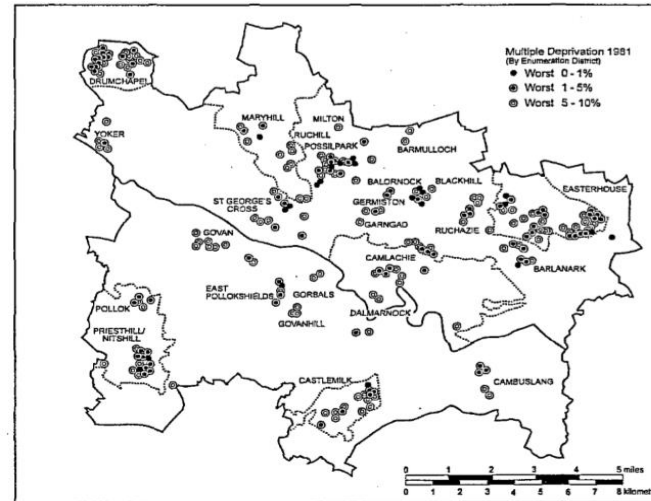


Fig. 3. The geography of disadvantage in Glasgow in 1981.

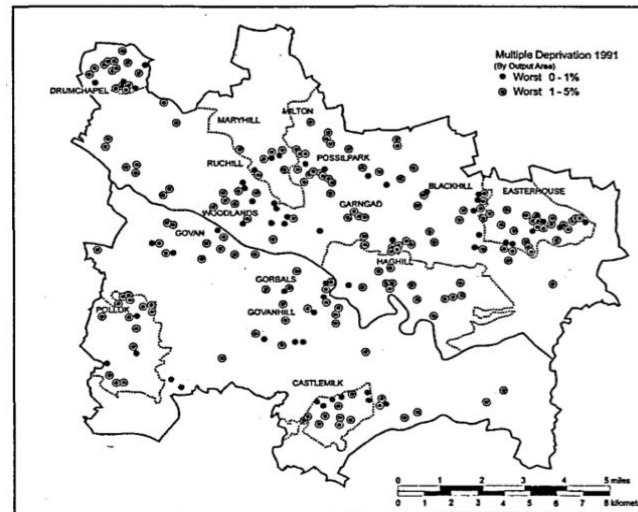


Fig. 4. The geography of disadvantage in Glasgow in 1991.

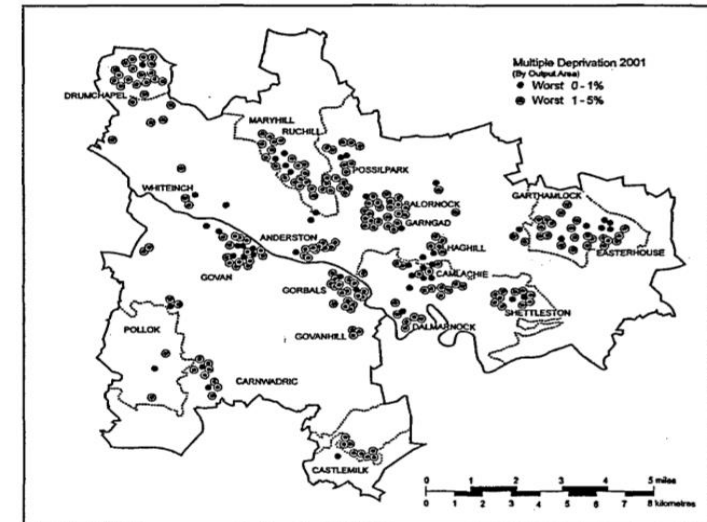


Fig. 5. The geography of disadvantage in Glasgow in 2001.
