

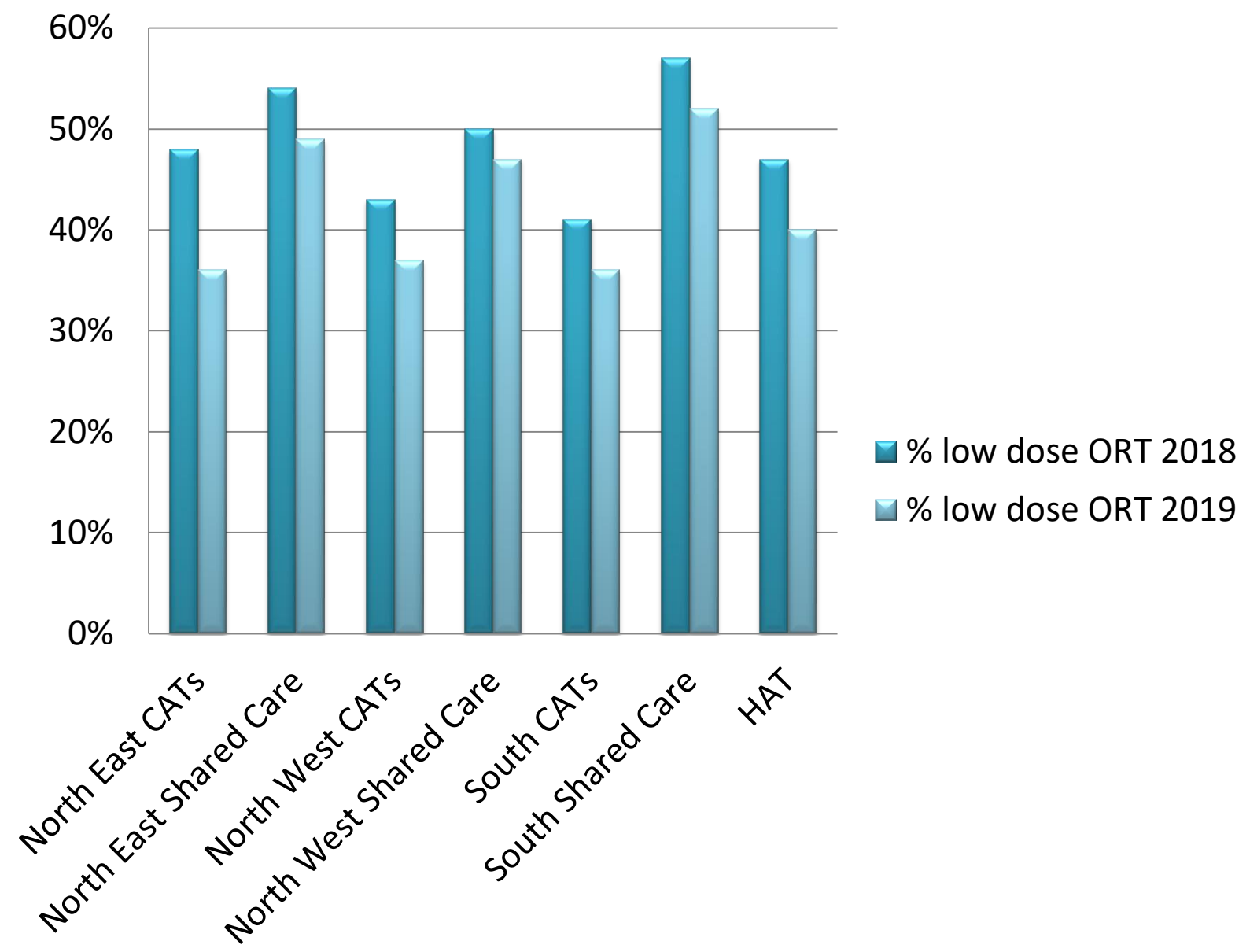
Barriers to Optimal Methadone and Buprenorphine Doses
